One day, Coco made a hat for her friend. Simple and elegant, it was different to the usual style. Coco made more and more hats, until she had enough to open a hat shop.















... and being different might make other people think differently too. That's why everyone now remembers the young Gabrielle as the great designer, Coco Chanel.
